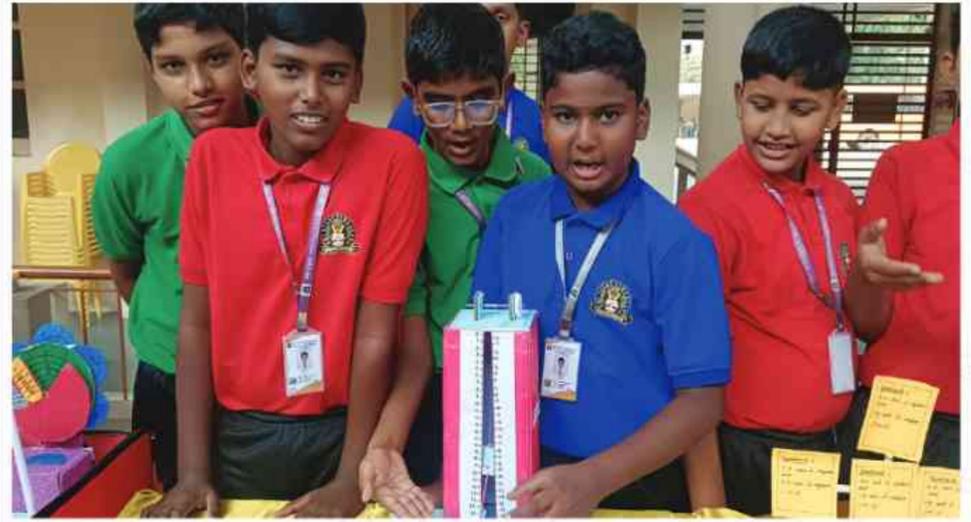
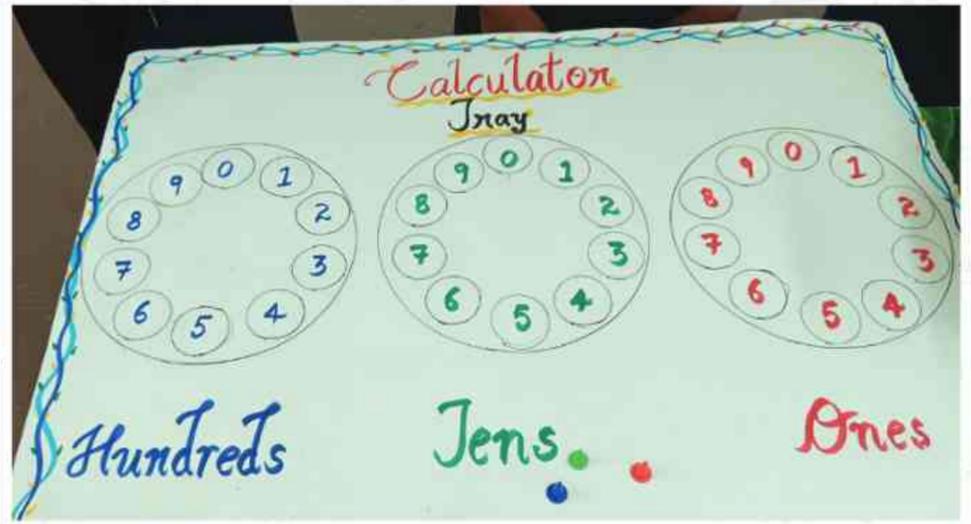
# SPELL BEE COMPETITION
